Classy Christmas designs with glitter galore.



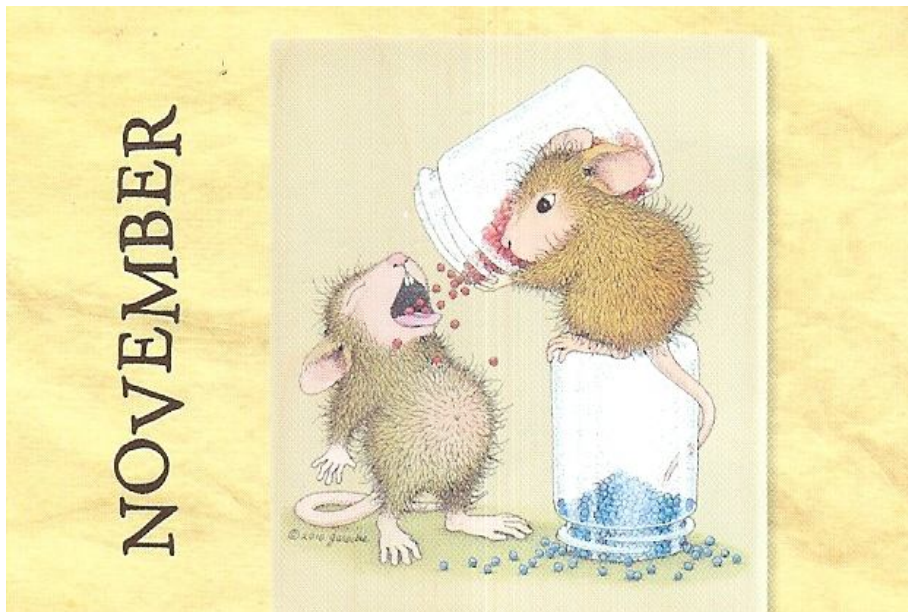
New Great Impressions Board:
